


## City of Lubbock Population by Decade 1910 - 2000




## Lubbock County Population by Decade 1910 - 2000




## Lubbock Retail Trade Area Population 1910 - 2000

# Lubbock Retail Trade Area 2000 Population and Percent Change 1990 to 2000







# Lubbock County 2000 Population Pyramid










# Deaths Lubbock County Residents 1997 - 2006





## Births Lubbock County Residents 1997 - 2006





# Airline Boardings ( Enplaned Passengers Only) Lubbock International Airport 2000 - 2009 In Thousands



# Population Density City of Lubbock 1910 - 2010





# Unemployment Rate United States, Texas and Lubbock County 2000 - 2009




## Percent Unemployed - Annual Average Lubbock County 2000 - 2009


**Labor Force - Annual Average


**Total Employment - Annual Average




## Percent Distribution of Non Farm Wage and Salary Employment Lubbock Metropolitan Statistical Area \* 2009












## Professional and Business Services Employment Annual Average Lubbock County 2000 - 2009 ( In Thousands )
















# Value of New Non-Residential Construction



# Number of New Single Family Homes City of Lubbock 2000 - 2009






