BEYOND LABELS: REDUCING STIGMA RELATED TO MATERNAL MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER

Reducing stigma and bias related to maternal mental health and substance use.

Learning Outcome:

The March of Dimes' goal is that women will be educated about and screened for mental health and substance use disorders throughout pregnancy and postpartum in a manner that reduces stigma and allows them to be connected with resources for prevention and recovery.



Learning Objectives:

Participants will be able to

- Describe what stigma is and why stigma among healthcare professionals matters.
- Describe how stigma affects women with mental health (MMH) and substance use disorders (SUD).
- Identify tools, such as the Beyond Labels website and strategies, such as the CARES Framework, that can be used to reduce stigma towards women with MMH & SUD.
- Engage with a team of experts to identify local and national resources healthcare professionals can use to improve access to care and treatment.
- Participants will demonstrate using the SBIRT tool to screen patients for substance use disorders and to provide interventions as needed.
