

Establishment of Board:

Established by Ordinance No. 696 in 1943. This commission is required by Section 211.007 of the Local Government Code for home-rule cities, and Chapter 2, City of Lubbock Code of Ordinances.

Membership Consists of:

- Nine (9) citizens at-large

Key Duties of the Board:

- Makes recommendations to the City Council concerning changes to zoning district boundaries in accordance with the zoning ordinance.
- Makes recommendations related to public improvements, civic improvements, city planning, opening and closing of streets, routing of public utilities, controlling traffic, and related matters.
- Makes recommendations to the City Council on changes, alterations, and additions to the zoning ordinance.
- Examines and approves proposals for the subdivision of land.
- Makes recommendations to the City Council concerning the Comprehensive Plan.
