## LUBBOCK ANIMAL SERVICES ADOPTION PROGRAM

At Lubbock Animal Services (LAS), it is our wish that every companion animal be placed in a loving, caring home. LAS works hard to ensure that an appropriate match is made to ensure an animal meets its new family's lifestyle. As part of our adoption program, we require a potential owner to complete an adoption application and interview with our adoption counselor. During the interview, potential owners are educated on the proper care of the new pet, common problems that may arise, and what responsibilities they have as a pet owner. The cost of adopting an animal is \$30 and includes age appropriate shots (FVRCP for cats, parvo, distemper, bordatella for dogs), as well as rabies vaccination and licensing. Also included in the cost is the implantation of a microchip and the spay/neuter of the animal (covers all cost for most local veterinarians). Staff and volunteers of the City of Lubbock Animal Services offer off-site adoptions of dogs and cats at various locations including PetsPlus once a month. Volunteer Orientation is held on the 1st and 3rd Tuesday of every month for those interested.
