

Establishment of Board:

The Parks and Recreation Board of the City of Lubbock, Texas was established in 1932. See City of Lubbock Charter, and Chapter 2 of the City of Lubbock Code of Ordinances.

Membership Consists of:


The Board shall consist of nine (9) members appointed by the City Council. Five (5) members of the Board, if possible, shall be appointed from the following fields:

- Civil Engineering
- Design and applied arts
- Park and recreation management, horticulture, landscape architecture, or a related field
- Any technical field appropriate to park operations.
- A person who has a knowledge, understanding or interest in the operation of a cemetery.

The City Manager, Director of Parks and Recreation, Director of Planning, and Director of Water Utilities shall be ex-officio members without a vote.

Key Duties of the Board:

- Advise and make recommendations to the city council
- May recommend to the city council such fees as may be needed for certain park and recreational facilities
- Has the duty to hear appeals from orders of the director of parks and recreation with regard to diseased trees under article 14.06 of chapter 14 of this code
- Shall study, investigate, counsel and advise the parks and recreation manager in developing and/or updating a written plan for the care, preservation, pruning, planting, removal or disposition of trees and shrubs in parks, along streets and in other public areas.
